St Christopher's provides end of life care of the highest quality across five South London Boroughs; Bromley, Lewisham, Southwark, Croydon, and Lambeth. In 2019/20 St Christopher's cared for more than 7,500 people at the end of their lives.

St Christopher's also offers bereavement counselling for adults and for children through their Candle Bereavement service as well as delivering various projects in the community to help people talk about death, dying, and loss. Providing these services costs around £22 million every year, yet only around £8 million of this amount is funded by the government, with the remaining amount being generated through fundraising.
