


Writing Composition Focus

Non-fiction

We will use available research tools to find out about a significant person in history. We will be exploring the life of Mae. C Jemison, who is the first female African American Astronaut.

Fiction

We will explore texts involving different types of journeys; looking closely at the images within the books we read to enhance the children's imagination and encourage analytical thinking. The children will additionally be developing their inference and prediction skills as well as continuing to write creatively. Children will enjoy using descriptive writing, drama and poetry to express their knowledge and ideas about key texts.
