By the end of our topic

Your child will know:

- What makes them unique and special
- Facts and information about influential and unique people in history.
- How to recognise and label parts of the human body.
- How to understand and identify their different senses.
- How to observe and talk about things in their local area and school.
- How to compare things that are old and new.
- That people are all different and special. We will learn about respect and understand why being different is important.

Your child will be able to:

- Talk about and write simple sentences to describe what makes them special
- Paint a self-portrait.
- Make a flap book to show how they are special.
- Recall and discuss facts about people who are unique and influential, both in history and in their local community.
- Name and label the five senses.
- Name and label parts of the human body.
- Compare and write about differences between our school now and schools in the past. Things that are old or new.
- To show respect and understanding for people that are different to themselves.
