Our topic this half term is: *Full, Full, Full of Love!*

We will be learning about special times and events for family and friends. We will also be looking at how we have changed since we were babies.

Ways to support your child at home:

Talking:

- about the different people in our families.
- about how they have changed since they were babies.
- about our likes and dislikes and what makes us special.

Reading:

- Continue to share and read stories, particularly those about families, such as *So Much*, *Once There Were Giants*, *The Gruffalo's Child*
- Continue reading (and singing) Nursery Rhymes.

Writing:

- Continue to experiment with different mark making; using pens, paints, chalk, tracing in sand or playdoh.

Maths:

Each week we will be focusing in detail on one number. You can help your child by

- Talking about numbers 1-5 and looking for them in the environment, for example door numbers, numbers on buses
- Singing number rhymes, such as *5 Little Ducks*, *5 Little Speckled Frogs*
- Counting out sets of objects up to 5.
- Helping them to show the numbers on their fingers.

Topic based:

- Finding out about celebrations and festivals, including Diwali, Bonfire Night and Christmas.
- Talking about the celebrations you share as a family
- Researching your family tree.
- Sequencing photos of themselves from being a baby up to now.
