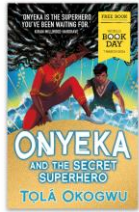
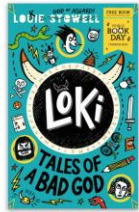


On the 7th of March we celebrate World Book Day. Tokens will be given out to all children. Here are a selection of books available for £1

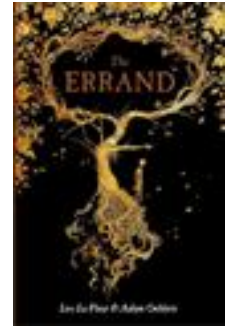
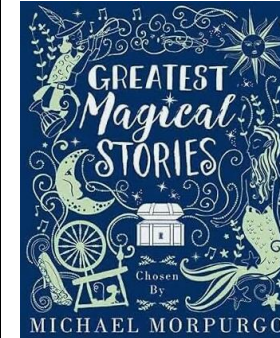


Grammar & Punctuation focus:

They will need to decide on two characters who their protagonist will encounter in the forest and use dialogue to effectively convey their character and to advance the action.
