Our topic is: Animal Kingdoms

By the end of our topic

Your child will know:

- About the 7 different continents of the world and what they are like.
- Facts about different animals and their habitats around the world.
- About colour mixing and painting techniques needed to create animal paintings.
- How to appreciate a piece of music that represents animal sounds and movements.
- About the different oceans around the world and some of the animals that inhabit them.
- How to name and group different types of animals and the food they eat.

Your child will be able to:

- Identify and name all 7 continents and 5 oceans around the World
- Recall and write about different animals and their habitats.
- Create detailed art projects themed around animals from each continent.
- Listen to and understand a piece of music, sharing their thoughts and feelings about it.
- Group and sort animals into different categories.
