

Reception Topic Letter Summer One 2024

Our topic this half term will be: Emergency Emergency! And Superheroes



In Maths we will be learning to: recognise common 2d and 3d shapes, recognise numbers to 20, counting on from different numbers, building numbers (e.g. we know 11 is a 10 and a 1), add together and subtract two small numbers (within 20).

In Literacy we will be learning to: read and spell Red Words, use our phonics to read, spell and write sentences independently building up to a short piece of writing, form letters correctly and enjoy listening to a range of topic-related stories and non-fiction books.

In other areas of the curriculum we will be learning: how to keep healthy by eating well and exercising. We will be finding out about different occupations, especially the emergency services. The children will be exploring forces and materials during their mini Superhero topic. During our Superheroes topic we have a special Superhero day in school where children can wear their home made superhero costumes and have a Superhero party. We will let you know the date as soon as possible so that you and your child can start planning a simple mask or outfit!

As the weather gets warmer please apply suncream before coming to school, and bring a named sun hat and a named water bottle.
