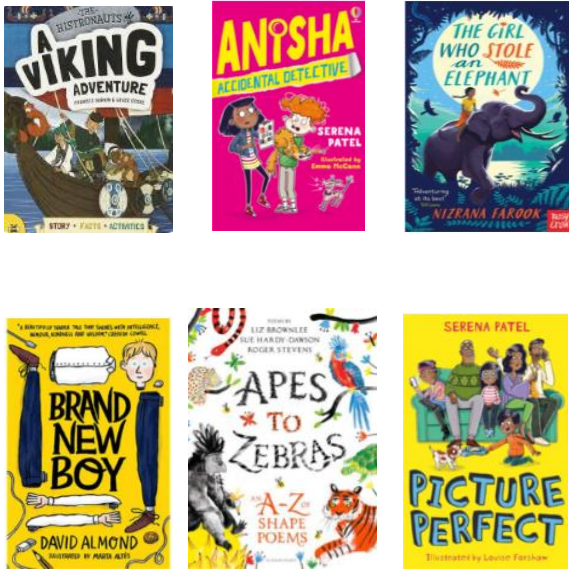


Suggested books to read at home:

Direct speech, possessive and plural apostrophes, fronted adverbials to indicate time, commas for clarity, maintaining the correct tense.

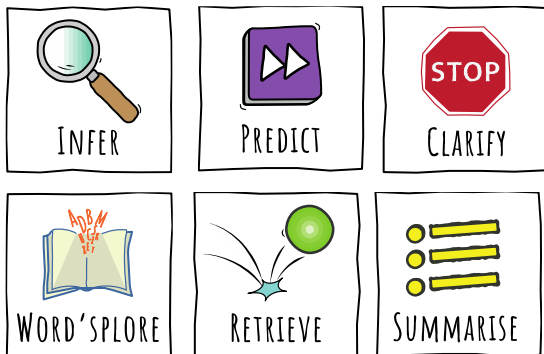
