

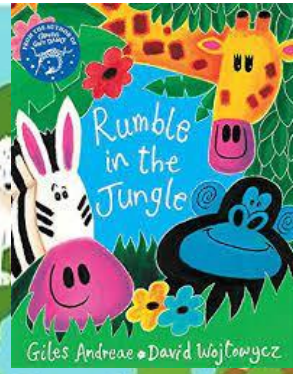

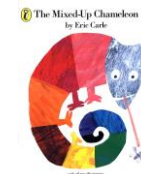

## Writing Composition Focus

The children will be writing riddles about their chosen animals including clues for the reader. Riddles will include full stops, capital letters and adjectives. The children will be reading these aloud to their peers to see if they can guess the animal.



The children will also be creating a fact file for their chosen ocean animal. They will research facts about them and create a fact file including full stops, capital letters and interesting facts.



The children will be writing their own short stories about mixed up animals. These will be based on the story of the Mixed up Chameleon by Eric Carle. These will include a beginning, middle and an end. The children will be reading these aloud to their peers.
