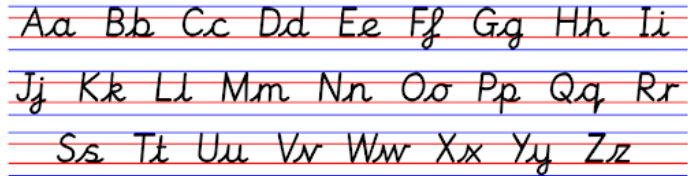


Handwriting Focus:

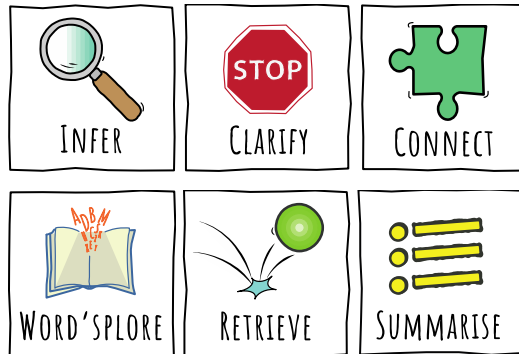
